



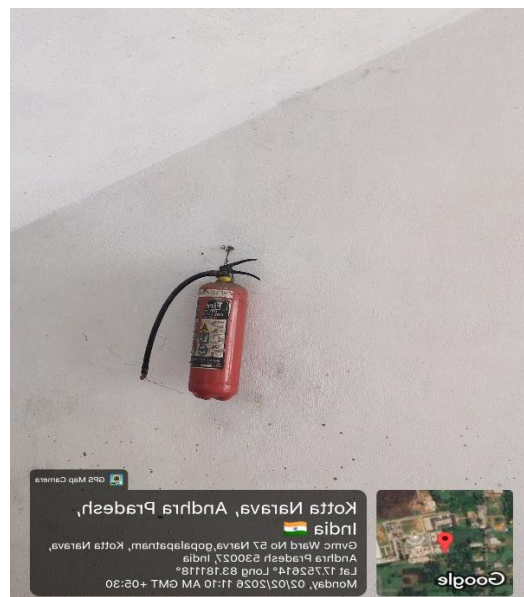
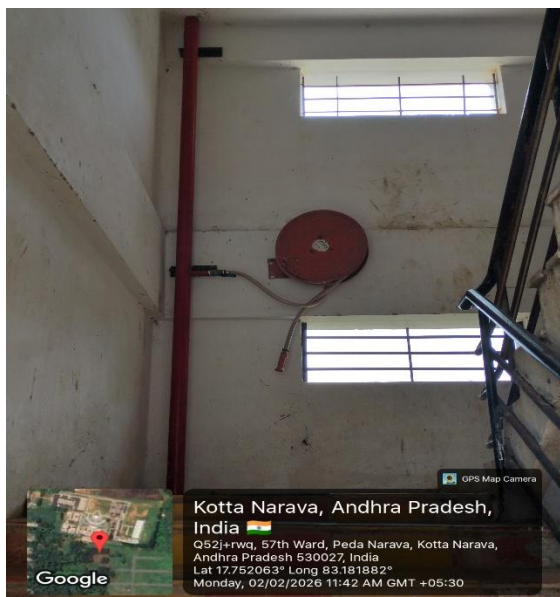
## Safety, Security and Disaster Management

- Adequate lighting in corridors, staircases, parking areas, and pathways

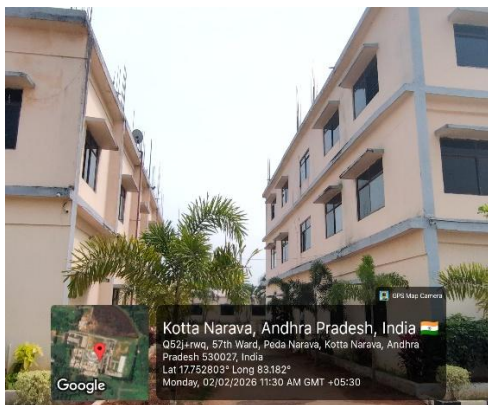


## Security Systems- “Security that watches, protects, and reassures.”

The Institution ensures a safe and secure campus environment through comprehensive security measures. **Trained security personnel** are deployed 24×7 at all campus entry and exit points to monitor and control access, maintaining a safe atmosphere for students, staff, and visitors.

**CCTV surveillance** is installed across classrooms, corridors, laboratories, the library, and common areas, providing continuous monitoring and enhancing campus safety. All visitor movements are recorded and regulated through **security registers**, ensuring controlled and documented access to the campus.

These measures collectively reinforce a secure environment, allowing students and staff to focus on academic and co-curricular activities with peace of mind.
